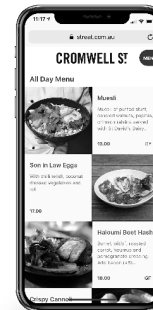

STREAT is one of Australia's leading food-systems social enterprises. The reason we love working so much in this system is its the one place you can improve both human and planetary health.

We run 12 hospitality businesses – 9 cafés/kiosks, a coffee roastery, an artisan bakery and a catering & functions business, a Youth Programs team, an Innovation Team and Green Team. The only reason we exist is to help young people with supported pathways into work.

STREAT employs over 75 professional staff (chefs, bakers, baristas, managers), has served over 4 million meals and coffees in the past decade and helped over 3100 young people.

STREAT offers pathways into learning and earning for some of Victorian's most vulnerable young people aged 16-24 in both hospitality and horticulture.

When a young person comes to STREAT they receive 6 months (Learning) and over 500 hours of personalized support, life-skills & employability training, accredited vocational training (Certificate II) and work experience within our businesses. A further 6 months (Earning) and over 700 hours of personalized support, employment (15-25hours per week) and employer support (STREAT also trains and supports the trainee's employer).
